Misuse of computers and/or Internet will result in a withdrawal of student privileges immediately and parents will be duly notified. The length of the ban will be determined by the Principal, ICT coordinator, Class Teacher and parents with consideration to the severity of the offence.

Once this form is returned to school your child will be able to use the school's computers and/or Internet.
